

Cookies

Legislation from the European Union means that websites must provide clear information about their use of cookies to customers. Cookies are files created by websites you've visited that store browsing information, such as login information, to save you having to remember them. They are small pieces of text - not viruses or computer programs - and cannot damage your PC or mobile device. To find out more about them, visit www.aboutcookies.org.

If you feel you would like to change your personal interaction with cookies, you can restrict or block those which are set by our website, or indeed any other website, through your browser settings. The Help function within your browser should tell you how.

We use Google Analytics to produce statistics about our visitors' use of the website to help us make improvements to the site. G stores this information on its servers in the United States. All information contained within these cookies is anonymous. Google may use the information it collects to show you selected adverts when you visit other websites. However, Google will not associate your IP address with any other data held by Google.

Privacy

Firms that handle personal information about individuals have a number of legal obligations to protect information under the Data Protection Act 1998 (www.dataprotection.gov.uk). It gives individuals certain rights as it defines the rules for processing information. It also states that those who record and process personal information, such as Eastwood Financial Services, must be open and honest in how it is used.
